

Call for ambulance

The following is the transcript of the medical dispatch tape from Jan. 12 supplied by the Coos Bay Police Department following the incident involving Carl Foster.

Dispatcher: North Coos 911 with a pre-alert for Coquille Ambulance. Standby for page.
(tones)

Dispatcher: North Coos 911 to Coquille Ambulance, request you respond to 440 East Third Street. Officers on scene at that location advising they need medical ASAP. Unknown any further. North Coos 911 to Coquille Ambulance, you're responding to 440 East Third. Officers on scene are requesting medical ASAP. Unknown any further. Time out 9:09.

Medic: Coquille Medic One, North Coos. We're enroute.

Dispatcher: Copy, Medic One, I have further. It's male subject, possible broken ribs. He is not breathing at this time. They cannot find an obstruction. He is conscious.

(pause)

Medic: Coquille Medic One, North Coos.

Dispatcher: Copy medic two.

Medic: North Coos 911, Coquille Medic One in route to CVH [Coquille Valley Hospital].

(pause)

Medic: Coos 911, Coquille Medic One arriving at CVH.

Dispatcher: Copy, Medic One. 9:27.
